

Changing Room Guidelines

Where possible, participants should try to arrive already wearing their dance wear or uniform. When using Freedom Studios changing facilities:

- 1. Visitors and participants should only use the designated male, female or disabled/family changing rooms. If you are unsure which room to use, please ask at reception.
- 2. There will be times when children will share changing rooms with supervising adults. Supervising adults must be the same gender as the child in their care.
- 3. No person of the opposite sex should enter the gender-specific changing rooms. The only exceptions to this rule are:
 - a. If a changing room is out of use and requires unisex use of a changing room facility. In this instance there will be a 'one at a time' system for usage.
 - b. A family is using the disabled/family changing room together.
- 4. We reserve the right to ask for young people to be supervised by parents, guardians, or staff, but cannot guarantee that children will be overseen at all times.
- 5. Children under eleven years of age must be supervised by parents or guardians while changing, and until their activity begins.
- 6. Mobile phones or other photographic or filming devices must not be used in the changing rooms for taking images or filming under any circumstances.
- 7. Live video calling applications must not be used in the changing rooms under any circumstances.
- 8. Any concerns or incidents must be reported without delay to the receptionist or to the teacher organising the activity.
